

## What OSCB safeguarding training should I do?

I am a...	My work	What I should do
...volunteer, board member, trustee	I do not work with children, young people nor do I have regular unsupervised contact with children.	<b>e-learning</b> <b>Introduction to Safeguarding and Awareness of Child Abuse and Neglect.</b>
...volunteer, board member, trustee	I work with children and young people and have some unsupervised contact with children but this is less than 3 times in a 30 day period	<b>e-learning</b> <b>Introduction to Safeguarding and Awareness of Child Abuse and Neglect.</b>
...volunteer, practitioner	I work with children and young people and have some unsupervised contact with children more than 3 times in a 30 day period	<b>Generalist</b> For those who work with children, young people with regular unsupervised contact with children. i.e. 3 or more times in a 30-day period. To be renewed every 3 years
...practitioner	I regularly work on a one to one basis with young people and / or work with particularly vulnerable young people.	<b>Generalist and Advanced</b> For those who regularly work one to one with young people or work with particularly vulnerable young people. For example; hub workers, health visitors and GPs. Advanced to be renewed every 2 years.
... manager	I have safeguarding responsibilities & deal with concerns raised by colleagues in my team.	<b>Generalist and Designated Lead</b> Specialist information on safeguarding responsibilities & dealing with concerns raised by colleagues in your team. For those colleagues with leadership or management responsibilities to safeguard children and young people within their role and/or who are designated leads within their organisation or setting. Designated Lead to be renewed every 2 years. You only need to do your generalist if not done in the last 2 years.
