We're seeking volunteers to work as Violence Reduction Navigators at the John Radcliffe Hospital in Oxford. Navigators are there to provide a listening ear and practical support to patients attending A&E due to incidents involving violence.

Navigators are on hand to help patients (aged 16-25) deal with complex social issues such as substance misuse, mental health, poor diet, poor personal care, and violence itself.

You will receive full training to enable you to signpost and refer patients to a number of services, helping them make a positive change in their life and take steps towards a brighter future.
